We work the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of each month in the garage at the Global Research Center from 1 to 4 in the afternoon. The New York State Library in Albany serves more than 30,000 clients in upstate New York who are visually impaired or otherwise unable to use books. The machines and books are supplied free of charge and there is no charge for mailing the machines and books. The Library sends us the machines and once we have completed all necessary repairs, we return them to Albany. The National Library Service for the Blind and Print Handicapped, a division of the Library of Congress supplies us with the necessary parts.
